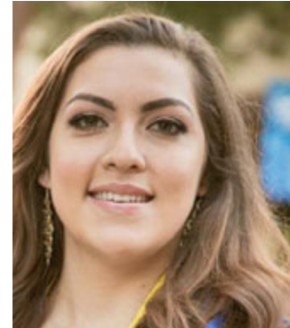

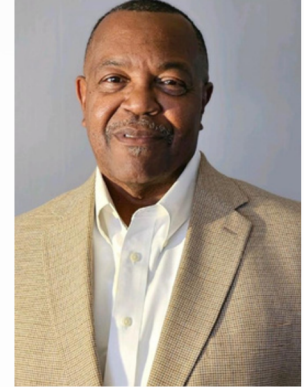

OUR PROGRAMS

Pathway From Boys To Men, Inc. (PFBTM) assists individuals with resources to find full-time or part-time job placement, career training, housing assistance, and mentorship. PFBTM also provides support services for housing resources, and transportation assistance.

Our Careers-Quest Program (CQP) is a workforce development program designed to train, educate and build highly effective skilled workers. Careers-Quest Program is a pre-preparatory program that focuses on the introduction to construction, through construction trades, apprenticeship programs, and career preparation and training as well as life skills classes.

OUR MISSION

Our mission is to provide resources and support to the underserved men, women, and youth in our community.

Our programs are designed to equip individuals with community resources and education assistance, and to increase their self-confidence -- things that are needed to live happier, healthier and more productive lives.

We have found that the paths that lead to displacement, violence, drug addictions, or imprisonment can be changed by the fellowship of successful role models.

DR. JOSHUA BECKLEY

Senior Pastor
Ecclesia Christian Fellowship

Six months after becoming a Christian at the age of 16, Pastor Beckley began preaching. He accepted his call to preach at 18 years of age and later became licensed in 1976. He began to follow God's will for his life. Leaving home in October 1977 for California, he left by faith, not knowing where he would stay or whom he would meet. Pastor Beckley left because God had called him. He was ordained in 1980 and continued his education, receiving a Doctorate in Ministry from The Centre for the Study of Biblical Research, a Masters in Divinity from the International School of Theology and a B.A. in Music Education. Before attending Golden Gate Theological Seminary, Pastor Beckley spent many years and many hours in self-education, learning the Greek and Hebrew languages, the disciplines of Hermeneutics, Homiletics and Exegeses. Through his dedication he has developed an extensive library of Biblical resources.

Pastor Beckley has served in full-time Christian work since 1977. He has worked with Dr. E. V. Hill at the World Christian Training Center as the Assistant Director of Activities in charge of High School Ministries. In less than one year he had Bible studies at eight of the inner-city high school campuses which included Dorsey, Locke, Manual Arts, Los Angeles High, Crenshaw and Morningside.

In 1979 he came on staff at First Baptist Church of Fontana, which is now Loveland Church. He served there for twelve years as Youth Pastor, Elder, National Youth Director for Harambee, Pastor of Visitation, Executive Pastor of Discipleship Ministries, and Executive Pastor of Counseling. Over the years he wrote extensive articles for youth magazines such as "Group." Pastor Beckley also wrote the first step booklet of the Three Steps to Christian Maturity Discipleship program at Loveland, and taught Step One, Wednesday night Bible Study and periodically preached on Sundays. In 1991, the Lord gave Pastor Beckley a vision of "Picking up the Broken Pieces in the Lives of Believers" from which our current ministry was born.

Pastor Beckley is presently the Senior Pastor of Ecclesia Christian Fellowship and has been the Pastor since its beginning. In his current ministry, as in his past ministries, Pastor Beckley is concerned about the well-being of people from all walks of life. He dedicates his life to spreading the Gospel of Christ to all he encounters. He encourages his membership to live a life that exemplifies Christ and shows forth the love which only comes from Christ.

Pastor Beckley has received numerous awards and recognitions for his service to the Lord Jesus Christ. His present extra-ministry responsibilities are Co-founder of the Inland Empire Concerned African American Churches (I.E.C.A.A.C.), Member of the Board of Trustees for Christian Community College in Redlands; and Member of the Alliance for Education; Member of the Century Club of San Bernardino City Schools, Board Member of Community Action Partnership; also a member of several other ad-hoc committees that are geared towards changing lives and conditions for our people and our communities.

However, Pastor Beckley says his greatest accomplishments since he met Christ, are his marriage to Lynda Carol; his three wonderful children Anton, Aliea, and Anell; and his grandchildren Cameron, Jayden, David, Dominic, Christian, Lailani, Calise, Alayna, Jalen, and Eva.

MAYOR ACQUANETTA WARREN

City of Fontana

Acquanetta Warren was elected as the City of Fontana's first female and African American Mayor in December 2010 and re-elected in 2018. Since taking office, Mayor Warren has and continues to be a strong advocate for economic development, jobs, affordable housing, public safety, a healthier community, and fiscal integrity.

Under the Mayor's stewardship, the City of Fontana was named by RentCafe the fourth Most Prosperous City in the U.S. (with a population over 100,000), as well as the Most Prosperous City in California. This acknowledgment followed the 2017 Fiscal Times' rating of Fontana as one of the financially strongest cities in the nation. From the day the Mayor was inaugurated, she has emphasized that Fontana is "Open for Business" and works directly with the Fontana Chamber of Commerce to support the needs of the business community.

This effort was rewarded in 2017 with the city being ranked fourth in California in the five-year annual growth of retail sales. During Mayor Warren's time on the City Council, there has been significant economic growth and infrastructure improvements including four reconstructed freeway interchanges resulting in reduced traffic congestion, safer streets, and ease of facilitating the movement of goods through San Bernardino County's "Inland Empire." In order to continue this economic growth, Mayor Warren began the "Mayor's Manufacturing Council," which saw more than 500 women attend the first annual Inland Empire Women in Manufacturing event.

Realizing that a strong economy requires a healthy community, Ms. Warren founded the award-winning program, Healthy Fontana. The program promotes an active community lifestyle and teaches smart nutrition choices.

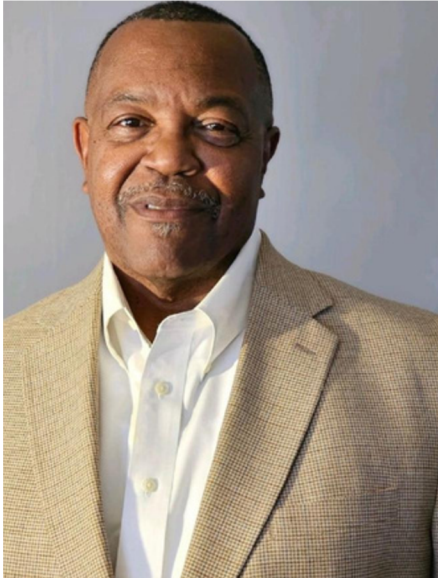
In 2016, the United States Conference of Mayors (USCM) named the City of Fontana the number one mid-sized city in the nation for eliminating childhood obesity. Ms. Warren has received numerous recognitions and several awards for her efforts throughout the Inland Empire, including 2017's Health Champion Award for Southern California Elected Officials from the California Center for Public Health.

A strong community also needs to feel safe. This is why public safety is among the Mayor's highest priorities. In 2013, Fontana was named one of the top 20 safest communities in the country.

Continuing to keep the community safe, the Mayor holds open conversations connecting the community with the police officers that serve to protect them so that the police officers can listen to the needs of the community. This is extremely important and helpful given the circumstances that we currently face.

Terrance Stone is Founder and CEO of Young Visionaries Youth Leadership Academy, President of Terrance Stone School and Community Consulting and President of The Southern California Black Chamber of Commerce High Desert Chapter. He is committed to steering young people away from the life that cost him much of his precious youth. In essence, Terrance is allowing his life mistakes to help others discover their personal worth and true-life purpose.

Terrance's change in heart, spirit and action has resulted in his reaching over 150,000 at-risk youth. He is also working on ways to help youth and adults understand that GOD has given them everything they need to succeed, it just needs to be located and activated.

His organization works with students on over 35 campuses in San Bernardino, Rialto and the High Desert, as well as visits with students in juvenile hall. He has been very instrumental in diffusing conflicts between gangs. He is also aware that without jobs, young people will take on negative behavior and for that reason, he was able to set up a workforce development program which gave young people training, jobs and a reason to stay focused on their school subjects.

Terrance and several of his male career members started a men mob where they visit middle and high schools at the beginning of the school day. They stand at the entrance to the school, all decked out with suits, shirts, etc., and greeted each student and encouraged them to have a good day. This has been such a success they are doing this in San Bernardino, Adelanto, Rialto, Fontana, Moreno Valley and Riverside.

The requests are steadily coming in as their presence have changed the attitudes of many of our youth. Terrance has made presentations in several states in the U.S and also internationally. His annual gala raises funds to provide scholarships for students and on the fun side, he can be seen with busloads of students at the Clippers, Lakers, Dodgers and Angel games. His passion includes providing food baskets for thousands of families at Thanksgiving and thousands of toys and more food baskets at Christmas.

In 2022, Kim was inspired to create The Black and Brown Opportunities for Profit (BBOP) Center, and the BBOP Hub, where black and brown women can access capital, information, technology, and networks needed to build, grow, and scale investable businesses, a system that works for by diverting from dealing with systemic racism and inequality.

Hollywood caught wind of Kim's dynamic life and clenched the deal with Taraji P Henson to direct the movie "Tell it Like A Woman" whereby the amazing Jennifer Hudson portrays Kim's life. Slated to be screened at the United Nations as a part of the Women's International Herstory Day in partnership Commission on the Status of Women. Available today on Amazon Prime.

Kim is also the author of Waking Up to My Purpose- a memoir highlighting her extraordinary life and available for sale today. Scholarly work includes: Epidemiological Modeling for Interventions addressing women in prison and channeling anti recidivism strategies post incarceration. This scientific health study resulted in the publication titled Invisible Bars- Barriers to Women's Health and Well-Being During and After Incarceration. Kim's awards total more than 200, and accolades have garnered her titles such as " Harriet Tubman, Unsung Hero, Community Pioneer, Trailblazer, Philanthropist, and Community Advocates.

While in his youth, Michael Anthony Davis had a promising career as a great football player. In his years at San Bernardino High, his outstanding performances were regularly cited in newspapers and sports articles. He was popular, famous, handsome, smart and well sought after by several universities in the nation. After careful consideration, Michael felt honored to accept the University of Southern California's offer. In his last year with USC, an even brighter future seemed to be in the making as he received an offer to sign as a free agent with the Seattle Seahawks!

Relating to his upbringing, Micheal was nurtured, loved and raised in a Christian household, when his father and several of his uncles were ministers. So he'd learned from his parents to Love God and to practice Bible principles in his early everyday life.

Unfortunately, because he enjoyed the benefits and attention that came with fame so much, he eventually lost sight of God. He thought he was untouchable and felt since he was special, that he could get away with anything and so he began to experiment with recreational drugs and then decided to become a drug dealer. Later, the distribution was halted. He got caught, busted and black balled for pro football, NFL.

In the meanwhile, his father died and with all of that, he spiraled down into a deep depression. Filled with embarrassment, disappointments, hurt and full of despair, for 35 years he'd succumbed to addiction.

Then on one particular day in 2014, unbeknown to him at that time, he was to experience a divine intervention. When he purchased and won a winning scratch off lotto ticket, things did not turn out the way he'd eagerly anticipated. This was the turning point towards a *Victorious Change for Michael*.

For a very long time, Michael yearned to be reto restored back to sobriety. He'd journal about his turmoils, ordeals, and experiences and now is able to share some of those with us.

God blessed him with a prosperous life of redemption from addiction. As to date, Michael is a motivational speaker. As a state certified drug & alcohol counselor, he is employed with 'Turn'. He helps parents with CFS cases, conquer addiction, and be reunited with their children. Along with his wife of 8 years, Vallery of Lafayette, LA, they are co-founders of their 501c3 non-profit program, 'You Go International Network, aka House of Redemption, providing homeless housing for the San Bernardino County Probationers. Michael is also a minister at Ecclesia Christian Fellowship located in San Bernardino, CA.

While in his trials with addiction, he learned several valuable lessons and finally came to realize why and how he could have fallen into the devil's trap. By observing, trying, and applying God's principles on a daily basis, he finally is reaping a sober successful lifestyle. He shares these techniques in his book entitled, "*Victorious Change*". This is Michael's testament!

Restoration House of Refuge

Clarinet in hand, marching with a spirit of excellence and jubilation around the track of Compton High School, celebrating a triumphant escape from the gang infested streets then known as “fruit town,” straight out of Compton, Alice always knew she was destined to lead others from prevailing darkness and abuse. Her jovial spirit was a magnet that attracted and encouraged many. The spirit of leadership and innate tendency for caring, giving, and loving others, prompted Alicer to continuously seek ways to assist.

After becoming a licensed Real Estate Broker, Alice established “Serving You Realty,” a company with black female agents. This immeasurable insight resulted in her ability to help hundreds succeed in obtaining home ownership. Being aware of the funding difficulty faced by many, she gave birth to AWA Financial Home Loans that assisted in meeting the needs of hundreds to pursue and secure, their “American Dream.”

Alice was an instrumental advocate for the NACA program, a program established from a lawsuit that involved Nations Bank and Bank of America, repaying the community for predatory lending practices. Potential homeowners were given the opportunity to buy with no money down and no closing cost; thereby, obtaining the knowledge needed to be an educated buyer.

With a heart to serve and assist members of the community, Alice Smith began a journey to pursue and help women who were destitute and homeless. As a result, in 2007, Restoration House of Refuge was launched and the doors were opened.

Restoration House of Refuge was established to provide sanctuary and minister to men, women and children; restoring and repairing lives." Serving our community has allowed us to form an alliance and collaborate with "Pathway From Boys to Men" and other community organizations; hitting the streets, providing and ministering to needs of men, women, and children. We are honored to be a part of their journey.

Alice became the first Shelter Bed Provider for the County of San Bernardino T.A.Y. (Transitional Age Youth) program that housed mothering women and accompanied women with one or more children from ages 0-5 years. Her spirit of excellence and willingness to serve gave birth to other programs that permitted her to house women youth offenders from the State of California. With a supportive husband of over thirty years, two beautiful children and five grandchildren, the journey has been challenging but ever so rewarding. "The Lord, our savior, has sovereignly orchestrated it all.

Every door, every opportunity was given by him and for him. The Lord gave us His word: "The Lord thy God will guide you continually." and satisfy your soul in drought. and strengthen your bones, You shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. Those from among you shall build the old waste places; you shall raise up the foundation of many generations, and you shall be called the repairer of the breach, And the restorer of the streets to dwell in." (Isaiah 58:11,12, NIV)
